THE HISTORY OF POLAR IN 16 OBJECTS

POLAR EXPLORATION KS4

POLAR 16: Lesson 2

Main Focus of activity:

Students are to create a short Radio Programme – The History of Polar in 16 Objects. They should work collaboratively to create and perform a script.

Learning Objectives:

To use the visual images of the Kit Bag to create a radio script that has the same quality of description and can hold the same interest for the listener.

Links to English Curriculum

Key Stage 3 and 4 Creative Writing and iGCSE Directed Writing and Composition

Suggested Lesson Activities:

Introduction

Discussion Point:

Students should watch the Video Clip Kit Bag in its entirety and think about the objects and the way in which they are described – what are their uses? Are there any surprises?

Main Part of the lesson

Teaching and Learning:

Using **Slide 2** on **L2 Polar 16 PPT**, show students the quotes taken from the Kit Bag clip.

There are 5 quotes which means it is possible for student to be divided into 5 groups.

Each group should work on the objects associated with their quote and work on the detailed description that could contribute to a script for a radio show on the History of Polar in 16 objects.

**If you have access to software such as *Audacity* and *Garageband*, you could create your own audio recordings and create a podcast channel using the LGfL podcast system. A podcast could be created for other classes to listen to, or produce the script for each group to perform to create the effect of a radio piece.

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Differentiation

It might be possible to show the clip again, without the sound to allow each group to make some notes for their descriptions.

Refer students to L2 –Resource sheet to help them in their planning and note making.

Plenary

Perform the final pieces as a script and ask listeners to find examples of adjectives, adverbs etc...
